10u Pool Games at Volunteer Park ONLY on SAT

ALL 10u and 11u Bracket Games at Volunteer Park on SUN

PROTESTS

All protests are settled by (site director) and the UIC in charge of your complex.

To protest a game you MUST pay \$200 CASH. IF your protest is reversed (YOU WIN) your money will be refunded.

If your protest is upheld you (YOU LOSE) your money is NOT returned

RULES

Pool Games

- 1) USSSA Federation rules
- 2) Your batting roster MUST BE STATED at home plate conference BEFORE start of the game—Know the last out and injury rules
- 3) Coin flip determines choice for home or away in pool play
- 4) Pool games can end in a tie
- 5) ALL pool games are 75 minutes “finish the inning” ---the score is what it is at the end of the time and complete inning.
- 6) Have your team ready to play 30 minutes before your teams’ pool play time slot.
- 7) Run (Slaughter) Rule: 12 after 3 innings- 10 after 4 innings- 8 after 5 innings.
- 8) Bracket Seeding is based on your ALL pool games

- 1) Winning Percentage - Descending
- 2) Number Wins - Descending
- 3) Number Loses - Ascending
- 4) Tied Teams (vs. each other) Winning Pct. - Descending [Not valid if all tied teams have not played each other]
- 5) Points Allowed
- 6) Run Differential
- 7) USSSA Points - Descending
- 8) Date Team Entered USSSA Database

Bracket Games

- 1) USSSA Federation rules
- 2) Higher seed determines choice of home or away in bracket play-IF SAME SEED COIN FLIP determines choice
- 3) Your batting roster MUST BE STATED at home plate conference BEFORE start of the game—Know the last out and injury rules
- 4) Bracket games that end in a tie when time expires will go straight into international tie breaker rules.
- 5) All Bracket games are 75 minutes “finish the inning”—
- 6) All final bracket championship games will be “finish the inning” and timed OR 7 complete innings which occurs first.

10u brackets will be 1 hour and 30 minutes time limit finish the inning
11u and 12u brackets will be 1 hour and 45 minutes time limit finish the inning
13u-14u-16u-18u will be 2 hour time limit finish the inning

***The site director has the final say on all protests or problems that may occur.

In case of a rain delay the site director has the right to change the tournament format in order to complete the event.
